



Kildare's Holds Angel Night Fund Raiser for Tsunami Victims

On January 16th, all three Philadelphia area Kildare's Irish Pub locations simultaneously hosted charity fundraisers called "Angel Nights". With generous out pouring of cash donations from patrons, donated tips from staff & salaries from management, Kildare's raised \$6,500 dollars for the victims. The donation was presented to UNICEF, which is working in close collaboration with the affected Governments to plan for long term relief. They are concentrating on rebuilding what has been destroyed, as well as to 'build back better' – better schools, better health facilities, and better opportunities for children
